Moss Problem?

Want to get rid of the moss growing on your cottage roof? Try this homemade solution...we did and it worked great!

- 1 Gallon White Vinegar
- 1 Cup Salt
- 1 Tablespoon dish liquid

Spray mixture on the moss using a garden/weed sprayer. When the moss turns from green to brown (1-2 days) just easily sweep off! And keep moss from growing back naturally by putting a small strip of copper at the peak of your roof. The rain water will wash the copper down and naturally prevent moss growth!

De-winterize Early!
